Jackson, MS Allstate agent urges Provine High School Students to "X the TXT" and have a Safe Prom

WHO: Teen members of the SAVE Chapter at Provine High School in Jackson, MS

WHAT: Sponsored by the Allstate Foundation, Provine High School's SAVE Chapter will host a Teen Safe Driving event on May 8, 2012. Activities will include the use of fatal-vision goggle demonstrations and an X the TXT campaign with the assistance of the Mississippi Department of Transportation. Participating Prom students will sign the "Provine's Prom SAVE Promise" banner. The banner entitled "X the TXT" will be posted at the prom on May 11, 2012. All signees will receive an "X the TXT" t-shirt, which will be worn to school on May 10th, a day before the prom. Their signatures on the pledge banner will serve as a symbol of their promise not to text and drive. Thumb bands given to participants serve as daily reminders to put their cell phones down behind the wheel and stay focused on the road. Allstate agent Samuel James of the Steven James Agency will be on hand to speak with students about the dangers of distracted driving. The SAVE Chapter is advised by Levi Williams.

HOW: Media is invited to speak with students about safe driving tips for all teens and the challenges and consequences of unsafe teen driving habits.
