Walters honored by SAVE

Wake Forest businessman Thomas Walters was honored at the annual summit of the National Association of Students Against Violence Everywhere (SAVE) as its volunteer of the year for his ongoing support of SAVE. The summit was held March 12 at North Carolina State University.

Walters owns three Allstate Insurance Agencies in Wake Forest and Wake County and has served on SAVE's board of directors for six years, during which he has secured several community grants for the nonprofit and donated items for the annual summit. He also speaks at many local school events promoting teen safe driving and overall youth engagement.
